- Homestay and insurance (standard policy only) fees per term are approximate. They will be calculated once arrival and departure flight details are received.
- Newlands College uses the NZ Student Plan by Uni-Care for international students. Please note this is a "standard" policy without pre-existing conditions or valuable items declared. Please see www.uni-care.org for the details.
- Homestay fee covers the cost of homestay supervision, a fully furnished room for individual students, three meals daily including snacks, and laundry services.
- If a student has a special dietary requirement, supplementary food costs will be discussed (approx.. \$30 per week)
- Airport pick up by the student homestay is arranged free for the student's first arrival.
- There is no charge for Homestay Placement for long-term students.
- Please note uniform, and subject related costs are not included in the fees above.
- Please allow expenses for school trips, itinerant music lessons, sports team activities and other activities, depending on the course the student is taking.
- Personal items, spending money and transport costs should also be taken into account. The "Studying in Wellington" pre-arrival guide (see "Study in Wellington" page on our website) gives advice on budgeting.
- Please allow approximately \$800 for uniform. For One-term study students, wearing their own school uniform may be negotiated.
